General Constraints



- All international activities must be worked through the appropriate office at NASA HQ
 - Canadian flyovers
 - Stopovers in foreign countries
- Typical time to work a simple request like a Canadian flyover is 30 days
- More complicated requests can take longer
- Logistical support, particularly cryogenic support, needs to be evaluated on a case by case basis
 - Arrangements are well established for Christchurch NZ
